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Goring Gambit

The Göring Gambit is based on the Scotch Game (1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.d4)

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and offers a black a pawn with 4.c3 after the usual exd4, or even two with 4.c3 dxc3 5.Bc4, called the double-pawn sacrifice in that last case.

The Göring Gambit This gambit is an offshoot from the Scotch Game, bearing the name of German player Carl Theodor

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Göring. White is willing to sacrifice a pawn (sometimes even two pawns) to open up lines for his pieces and to accelerate his piece development.

The Göring Gambit is a 19th-century style gambit beginning with 1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.d4 exd4 4.c3!?! (or 2.d4

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exd4 3.Nf3 Nc6 4.c3). White can of course recapture with 4.Nxd4, the Scotch Game, but in the Göring Gambit White instead offers the d-pawn as a gambit - this opening is essentially a Danish Gambit (1.e4 e5 2.d4 exd4 3.c3) with Nf3 and ...Nc6 inserted.

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White sacrifices one or two pawns in return for a lead in development, and typically follows up by putting pressure on f7 with Bc4, Qb3 and sometimes Ng5, while Nc3-d5 is another common motif.

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Göring Gambit Accepted- 4...dxc3
5.Nxc3 Black's most critical test of the gambit is to accept it, and if you know what you're doing, accepting the gambit offers Black good winning chances. However, it also gives White what he/she wants, and gives White the majority of the piece play and attacking chances, and the resulting positions

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often become complicated very quickly.
